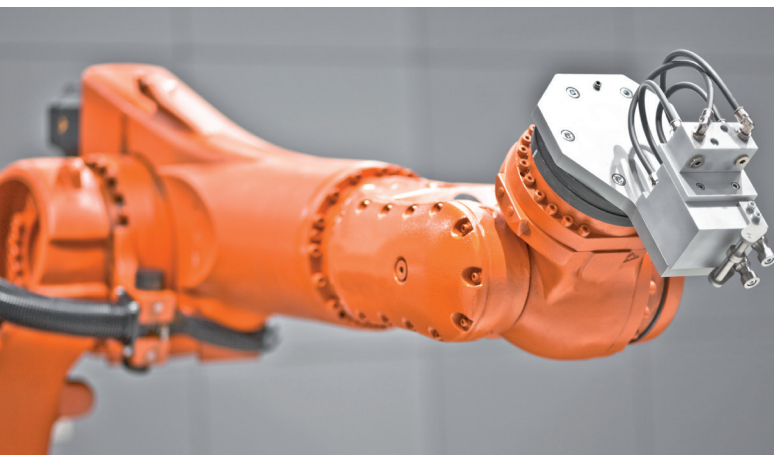

Admission Requirements

- **High School Education:** International Baccalaureate (35 Points) / A-Levels (82%) / Abitur (2,3)
- **SAT Scores** (Math, Reading & Writing) (1.200 (new SAT))
- **Subject Knowledge:** Mathematics, Physics + Additional science (Chemistry preferred) 1. Higher Level knowledge / 2. Excellent grades (e.g. 6/7 (IB)) / 3. Taught in the last 2 years OR without Higher/Advanced Level in a.m. subjects, you can send in your SAT Subject Test in Physics
- **English Language:** Mother tongue / Language of instruction for the past 5 years / TOEFL (570 pb // 240 cb // 95 iBT) / IELTS (6.5) / TOEIC (880)

- SAT scores
- Passport photograph
- Personal statement
- Declaration of financial support
- Two letters of recommendation
- English language proficiency test certificate, unless English is your mother language or has been the language of instruction for the last five years
