



Guide for the application to B.Sc. in Mechanical Engineering (International) via the KIT Online Application Portal

This step-by-step guide shows you how to apply to the B.Sc. Program in Mechanical Engineering (International) via the KIT Online Application Portal. You can apply between December 2021 and April 30th, 2022 for a start in the winter semester 2022/2023. Don't forget to register for the CBS College Program afterwards to ensure your exclusive spot.

Please have all your documents (High School Certificate / Transcript of Records, English Language Proficiency Proof, SAT, Motivation Letter and optional documents) ready as electronic PDFs to be uploaded onto the portal.












2. "Hochschulzugangsberechtigung" (HZB): Entry qualification international




All available documents must be uploaded here. Should you have any recommendation letters available, they can be submitted here as well.

The English Proficiency document must be submitted in the category "English Language Skills".







3. Past courses


Please fill in the information about your past studies. If you have not studied before, please select "No previous study periods existing" and continue to the next category.



6. Special purpose application

You have the option of submitting special applications in addition to your normal application. These requests are governed by the Ordinance of the Federal Ministry of Education and Research on the Allocation of Study Places in Admission-Restricted Study Programs by the Universities of Baden-Württemberg, as well as the Admission and Enrollment Regulations of the KIT (see official announcements). Special applications are subject to strict requirements. Please check whether you meet the requirements for a special application before adding it, using the explanations on the right.

The following special application types are only available for bachelor's degree programs with restricted admission (1. Semester):

- Preliminary selection
- Disadvantage compensation / Improvement in waiting time
- $\circ~$ Disadvantage compensation / Improvement in the average grade

The following special application types are permitted for all admission-restricted study programs (only 1st semester):

- Hardship application
- Local binding in the public interest

Please note that the special application and all supporting documents relating to the application must be received by the university in due time with your application for admission to the study program so that it can be taken into account in the award procedure.

Invalid applications will not be processed!

- Multiple entries are possible by clicking on the "new" symbol.
- → "Save" your information and choose "next".


