You can apply between December 2023 and April 30th, 2024 for a start in the winter semester 2024/2025. These requests are governed by the Ordinance of the Federal Ministry of Education and Research on the Allocation of Study Places in Admission-Restricted Study Programs by the Universities of Baden-Württemberg, as well as the Admission and Enrollment Regulations of the KIT (see official announcements). **Special applications are subject to strict requirements. Please check whether you meet the requirements for a special application before adding it, using the explanations on the right.**

The following special application types are only available for bachelor's degree programs with restricted admission (1. Semester):

- Preliminary selection
- Disadvantage compensation / Improvement in waiting time
- Disadvantage compensation / Improvement in the average grade

The following special application types are permitted for all admission-restricted study programs (only 1st semester):

- Hardship application
- Local binding in the public interest

Please note that the special application and all supporting documents relating to the application must be received by the university in due time with your application for admission to the study program so that it can be taken into account in the award procedure.


